1939 CHRISTMAS FIESTA INVITATION



Monroe and West Monroe Christmas Fiesta Band, 1939

Special Collections contains an invitation created for St. Matthews School, asking them to participate in the Monroe-West Monroe Christmas Fiesta to be held November 30, 1939. The invitation contains information from the 1939 Christmas Fiesta and letters from Monroe Mayor H. H. Benoit, West Monroe Mayor H.M. Williams, Jr., and G.D. Holland, Secretary of the Monroe and West Monroe Chamber of Commerce. There are pictures of the 1939 St. Matthews' queen, the 1939 St. Matthews' float with queen and maids, along with group pictures of all the queens and maids and parade scenes. Northeast Junior College (now ULM), Bastrop, Newellton, Jonesboro-Hodge, Tallulah, Ruston, Bish Mathis Institute, Neville, Ouachita Parish, Columbia, Louisiana Tech, Rayville, Monroe Commercial School, Homer, and St. Matthews School bands, queens and maids of honor participated in the Fiesta.

Christmas Fiesta Parade, 1939

The invitation contained detailed instructions for the 1939 Christmas Fiesta festivities which included a “mammoth” parade with 30 beautifully decorated floats to be staged at 11:00 a.m. and a 2:30 p.m. football game with band performances at half time. The day began at 9:30 a.m. when queens and maids were to arrive at their complimentary room at the Hotel Virginia. Pictures were taken in the hotel lobby and then city buses carried the group to the parade floats. A luncheon followed at 12:45 at the Hotel Virginia. Then immediately after lunch, queens and maids were carried to Northeast Junior College for the football game. While queens and maids were provided transportation, because of the large number of participating bands, they were required to have their own transportation. The mass band concert was under the direction of Mr. Harry Lemert. Complete instructions for band directions were included in the invitation booklet.

The parade formed at Elysian Fields Street, moved forward and westward down DeSiard Street, across the old traffic bridge and through West Monroe and then across the new traffic bridge on Louisville Avenue where it ended on North Sixth Street for a total distance of 16 blocks.
